8. Frost

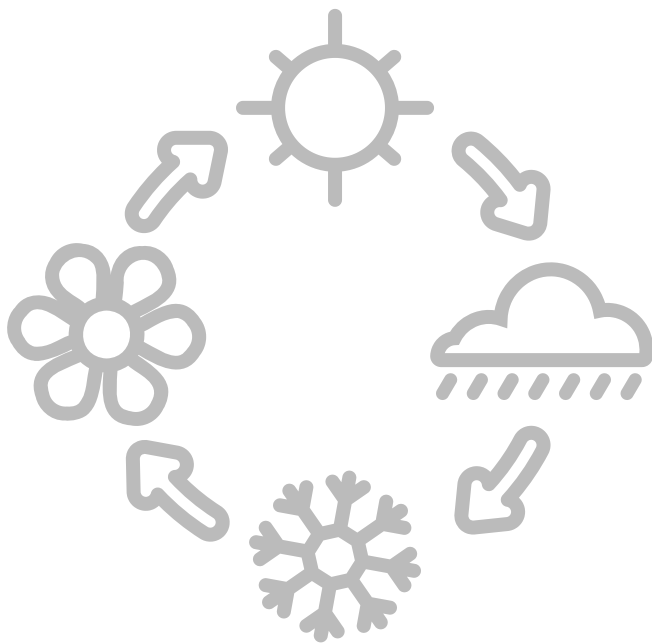
- a) A warm breeze that occurs in spring.
